February 1, 2017

- Treasurer's Report-\$11,000 in checking and \$38,100 in savings
 --VCPC grant completed and submitted
 -next month we will discuss budget planning for next year
 --budget committee-Val will approach current families who will be returning next year
- Admissions Report-CDC does not require that parents fill out criminal records check or have references; for next year, we will still require criminal records check but not references
 --we currently have 40 children registered for next year

4. Director's Report

--VCPC grant mid-year report submitted, have not yet received word of its acceptance

--Weekend cleaning...3 weekends still open; will be assigned to families who have very few volunteer points

--STARS renewal sent out and received. Requested 5 stars instead of 4---if approved, will receive \$1,550 bonus; Will know within 4 weeks to hear of status; required to do annual satisfaction survey in the Spring (need 80% participation); several parent volunteers will be filling out "Strengthening Families Program" questionnaire

--concerts will be planned (for the end of the school day) for the week before Memorial Day (most likely May 23, 24 & 25); Each class will have its own separate concert; Morning classes will perform upstairs. Afternoon classes will perform on the stage downstairs; HES kids coming to the Rec. afterschool program will stay outside until concerts are over
