#### **Director's Report**

Shawna contacted VINS to discuss the contract with VINS for the year. The September visit is to be reimbursed and the first visit is to occur on October 6<sup>th</sup> and will be held outdoors. The contract is also to be updated to reflect only 2 classes this year and thus, the cost of the program will be less this year.

Yujin Silver and her family did a thorough clean of the space beneath the stairs. Many items needed to be properly disposed of and \$25 will be reimbursed for the disposal fees paid.

Speaking of the storage space beneath the stairs, the poor conditions and efficacy of the space is brought up again. Many of the outdoor items continue to see exposure to dirt, salt, and the elements due to the poor conditions in the space. The tarp has reduced the exposure, but only minimally. It is suggested that we start thinking about outdoor storage solutions to ensure longevity of these items, perhaps through a shed or similar option. This topic is to be continued in the October Board Meeting.

The "Shelter-in-Place" bin located in the Hallway of the building needs to be re-stocked. Families will be asked to donate 2 non-perishable items.

As Shawna mentioned previously, the Bright Wheel app will be discussed with Val when she returns so that it may be paid for and the demo completed. The app will allow parents to check-in their child(ren), view snack options for the day, view/share photos taken throughout the day by the HCNS staff, and allow for easy communication with staff as well. Coming soon!

A bill associated with the HCNS website is to be paid upon Val's return.

The new and improved Board Meeting minute process. The minutes from each board meeting will now be sent out by Shawna with the next Weekly Newsletter, allowing for all items to be posted to the website together. These should be available by the following Sunday evening at the latest.

Proactive Planning: HCNS will follow the guidelines released by the Department of Health if any local schools experience a case of COVID-19 during the school year. <u>This topic will be further discussed and clarified at the October Board Meeting.</u>

Shawna reports that the morning health check screenings have been going extraordinarily well. Her only concern is the excessive fogging of the state-provided face shields. She and Yujin have resorted to goggles, but these also cause fogging, so there was a recommendation to try taping the face mask to the bridge of the nose. If this process still yields fogging of the shield, we may consider seeking skin tight goggles so that a clear view of each student is possible during health checks.

School Photos during COVID- The decision has been made to offer school photos this year! Alberto Paniagua will return as the photographer. The school will cover the cost of \$150 for him to return and will perform a health check to ensure students are safe. The photographer will also maintain social distancing during the photo session and a group photo WITH masks may be able to occur, if desired, in addition to individual photos. Families will be notified of the date chosen. Coming Soon!

Did you notice the awesome sitting pads made for the students when they are outdoors? Shout out to **Amanda Yates**for whipping those together right before the start of the year! These are made of reusable shopping bags and make for easy cleaning/sterilization! **Thank you**, **Amanda!** 

Shawna and Yujin have noted that with the necessary sterilization and cleaning required before and after the school day, more time is spent preparing and cleaning up. It is to be discussed with Val about adding 30 minutes to both the beginning and end of Yujin's contract regarding hours in order to help with these processes each day as it is more than a one person job to ensure student safety. Yujin has been graciously coming early and staying late in order to assist with these tasks.

The school year is off to a great start. Second classroom has been cleaned and re-organized so it can be used if needed for inclement weather. Heather White is to send an email to David with the town regarding one of the windows in the spare classroom, as that window needs a screen.
